



London Road Surgery: findings from a Healthwatch Reading visit

Where: London Road Surgery, 172 London Rd, Reading, RG1 3PA

When: 27 January 2016 for 2 hours in the morning, and 1 February 2016, for 1 hour

Who: 21 people over the 2 visits spoke with a trained Healthwatch staff member

Why: Healthwatch Reading is visiting all local GP surgeries to get patient views

How: Healthwatch used 'Enter and View' powers to visit on a pre-agreed date



What patients like

- 17 out of 21 patients were happy with the care, treatment and service they received
- 14/21 patients were satisfied with the opening hours
- 13/21 could always be seen on the same day for an urgent matter



What patients dislike

- Some patients mentioned lack of evening or weekend appointments



Healthwatch observations

- No patients during the visits said they had booked online so this may need more promoting
- Leaflets and posters are displayed in a number of different languages
- The waiting area is small, so it is difficult for patients at the reception window to have private discussions

Patients' suggestions

- A few toys for children to play with, would help if appointments were running late

'They are very helpful...I wouldn't be anywhere else.'

'I don't get to meet the doctor of my choice.'

'The doctor speaks Punjabi.'
(Positive comment from a patient who is a Punjabi speaker)

'By 10am there can be no appointments, [so need to] go to walk-in centre.'

How the surgery has responded to the patient feedback

'We are continually trying to improve access and we welcome patient comments on how to improve our services.'

We feel that we offer a good range of timings for all of our patients including mornings, afternoons, late night and a monthly Saturday clinic.

We do not have toys in our waiting room purely for infection control purposes, the toys would have to be cleaned and sterilized on a daily basis.'
